Recommended supplies to bring:

- -for a wreath: 12" reusable wire or grapevine wreath form (about \$6 from Michael's)
- -for a wreath: fine florist wire (from Michael's, Dollar Store, etc.)
- -4 candles and holders. One pink and 3 violet candles are traditional. Or bring 4 real or electric tea-lights and 4 clear glass holders, jars or glasses: we'll provide coloured tissue to wrap the holders.
- -boughs of evergreen from your yard, the river valley, or a florist; or you can bring a ready-made wreath and finish it at our event; or you can just decorate a nice branch
- -ribbon, violet is traditional: you'll need about 3.60 m to wrap around a wreath
- -shears or a knife and gloves if your boughs are prickly
- -a bag to carry your project home
