

A is from the book of Matthew 21:28-32¹. In this parable, Jesus tells the story of two sons. The father asks both sons to work in his vineyard. The first son initially refuses but later changes his mind and goes to work. The second son agrees to work but does not follow through¹. Jesus asks which of the two sons did the father's will, and the people respond that it was the first son¹. Jesus then explains that tax collectors and prostitutes, who initially did not follow God's ways, are entering the kingdom of God before the religious leaders because they believed and repented¹.
